## **The FieryCentral\_Update1\_170 patch resolves the following:**

- Issue that prevented creating Printer Groups or accessing the DSF tab in Fiery Central Manager when Fiery Central is running on a non-English system.
- Issues that prevented Flow workflow assignments from being recognized by a job on a non-English system.
- In Job Properties of a Fiery Central server, an issue was resolved when defined Mixed Media covers failed to print.

## **Known Issues:**

- Some language translations are still pending and will be updated in the Fiery Central 1.7.1 release

## **Updating Procedures for Release 1.7.0 Patch Update 1**

When you update the Fiery Central software from an earlier software version, please use one of the following procedures. Note the patch is only supported from Fiery Central v1.7.0.

### **TO UPDATE FROM FIERY CENTRAL VERSION 1.7.0 with the Patch using System Update:**

If System Update is enabled, the 1.7.0 update patch will automatically be downloaded and, depending on settings, may be automatically installed. If it is not enabled, you can use the following procedure to install the update.

1. Launch System Updates from Start, Programs, Fiery.
2. Click the "Check Now" button to check for available updates.
3. If the update appears in the list, select it and click "Install".

### **TO UPDATE FROM FIERY CENTRAL VERSION 1.7.0 with the Patch via download**

**NOTE:** The update software is a .zip file which can be downloaded from the Downloads and Demos section of <http://www.efi.com/products/production/fierycentral/support/>. You must extract and save the contents to a location on your desktop before you can install the software update.

1. Double Click on 'FieryCentral\_Update1\_170.zip'
2. Download and save the file.
3. Unzip the FieryCentral\_Update1\_170.zip.
4. Double Click on the FieryCentral\_Update170Upd1.exe file to install
